CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Women's College Code of Conduct for students is listed as General Guidelines in the College Prospectus.

- ❖ A Student must pass all her semester examinations within six years from the date of admission to the first semester course.
- ❖ A student who i) has completed her course of study of a semester but fails to enroll herself to appear in any semester examination or ii) fails to appear at the examination after getting duly enrolled or iii) has been declared 'failed' in that examination, may be allowed to appear at the subsequent examination within her stipulated chances as a continuing student on submission of prescribed application form and fees within the stipulated date determined by the University.
- ❖ A student must wear college uniform from the date of commencement of classes. The dress code is: White Trouser, Pink Kameez, White Dopatta, OR, Pink Saree, white Blouse.
- ❖ A student must keep the IDENTITY CARD with her, ★ provided by the College.
- ❖ The name of the students, who will keep herself absent from college for one month continuously, may be struck off the attendance register.
- ❖ EACH AND EVERY STUDENT MUST SIT IN THE INTERNAL ASSESSMENT EXAMINATIONS.
- ❖ Mobile should be kept in silent mode/switched off mode in the class room. Mobile/Electronic Gadgets/Pagers etc. are not allowed in the Examination Hall.
- ❖ A student should be a member of Whatsapp group of each subject she is studying in the college and provide her mobile number, email address to the respective Head of the Departments.
- ❖ All Minority/ Person with Disability/Central Sector/ Ishan Uday/S.T/S.C/OBC category students must apply for Post-Matric scholarship, National Scholarship (https://scholarship.gov.in), Dr. Ambedkar Post-Matric scholarship (for EBC) through online mode only and L.I.G, Girls' Stipend and Merit-cum-Means stipend through offline mode within the stipulated dated notified by Stipend Section. The notice regarding the required documents and last date of submission are displayed in the College Notice Board. The students must contact the Stipend Section for further queries, if any.
- ❖ A student have an option to join in N.C.C /N.S.S. Programme.
- * RAGGING IN ANY FORM is absolutely banned inside the campus and strict measures will be taken against any offender. To maintain the discipline and combating any form of ragging inside the college, a "Discipline and Anti-ragging Committee" keeps vigil and makes round the clock observation.
- SEXUAL HARASSMENT in any form is prohibited within the campus and a "Committee for Prevention of Sexual Harassment" chaired by the Principal monitor any such complaints.
- Discipline is one of the most important yardsticks by which an academic institution is measured and evaluated. The college authority expects good manner, sanctity, discipline and befitting decorum from students in and outside the college. A student violating these sacred values and indulging in anti-social, destructive and undesirable activities, is liable for punishment.
