Every year students of this department organized a programme on TEACHERS DAY. Students participated in the programme and try to giving their level best by dance, song , recitation, drama etc.





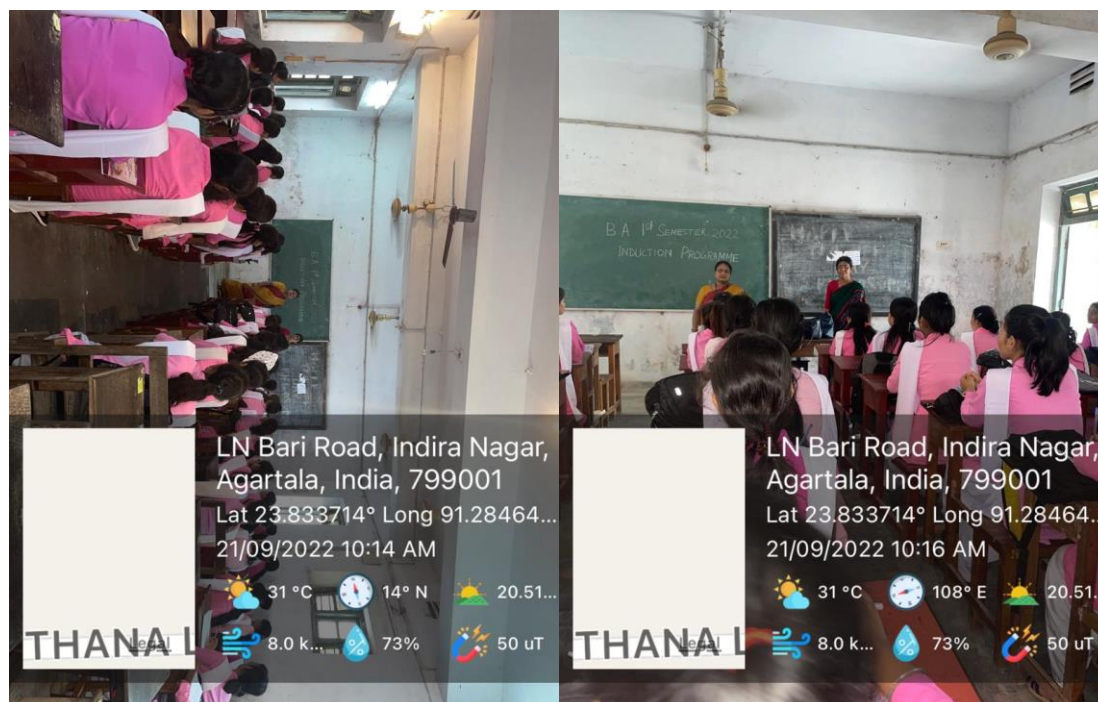
STUDENTS INVOLVEMENT IN DIFFERENT AREAS:-
